



Re: CARVER ATHLETICS WINTER SEASON FEE 2014/2015

Dear Parents,

Let the winter sports season begin. Along with the pleasure of watching your kids play at games, and driving them to and from practice, there are some season fees that need to be paid. This fee covers the following: tournaments, league, reffing, and equipment fees. These fees do not apply to Provincials if we qualify.

There will be an *informational meeting for all levels and genders on Wednesday, November 26, at 7pm* during our 1st HOME games of the season against Meadowridge and St. George's starting at 4pm. Please come out and cheer on your Phoenix Basketball Teams by meeting in the gym before heading into a classroom for our meeting.

Basketball costs are usually the most expensive out of any season. The Athletic Department has put in \$1000 to help subsidize costs for all participants. The cost of participating in basketball this year for the participants will be \$250.00. Please also note the separate jersey deposit of \$50 on the Parent Contract. This will only apply to the Junior and Bantam Teams.

The Senior Boys team will be acquiring new personalized home & away jerseys this year. The cost is an additional \$100. The players who have their jersey from volleyball would only need to purchase 1 other jersey which will cost them only \$50 instead of \$100.

Season and jersey fees are due by Wednesday, November 26, 2014.

2nd payment of \$75: Friday, January 16, 2014

Final payment of \$75: Monday, February 16, 2014
