

Break your testimony into the following parts:

- What your name is.
- Where you live and go to school.
- How old you are.
- Something you like to do: sports, hobbies, going to youth group, working, etc.
- How many people are in your family?
- Your life before you received Christ.
- How you received Christ. What actually happened?
Were you reading the bible? Did someone pray with you?
Are you still considering who God is in your life?
- Your life after you received Christ and the changes that took place.
- Why believing in Jesus is important to you.
- Explain how you asked Jesus into your life. Someone else may be in the exact same situation as you are and may be able to trust the Lord after hearing your testimony.
- A scripture verse that has been significant to you and why it is important.
- A challenging thought to your audience (i.e. If you don't know God, try reading the bible or going to a church that loves Jesus Christ)
